With two employees and one old stake body truck, they spent their days doing field work and nights doing paperwork and design.

Today, entering their seventeenth year of business, LDG has grown to become a well respected Bucks County landscape design/build company. LDG has two full-time architects on staff and runs five installation crews. Its reputation is based on cutting edge quality and creativity. Although LDG specializes in design/build master plans for large scale residential properties that can be phased in over a period of years, the firm has extensive experience in commercial products. LDG has been responsible for such projects as the Fischer-Porter headquarters, Neshaminy Interplex-Korman Corporation, Talamore at Oakterrace, Georgetown Crossing, Lambertville Square and Lambertville Hotel.
