Today the enterprise is a complete design-and-build operation that includes project landscape architect Carl Molter (pictured center) as well as two other landscape architects and thirty field personnel. Equally knowledgeable in the areas of design, construction and plant selection, the brothers listen carefully to the needs and wishes of their clients, then add creativity, artistic sensibility and attention to easy maintenance, deer resistance and new hybrids. The combination has brought the firm satisfied customers and many



awards. The newest honors are two gold medals bestowed by the Pennsylvania Landscape and Nursery Association for excellence in landscape design—one for a residential property, the other for a commercial property, the courtyard of Doylestown's historic Aldie Mansion. The latter project also earned LDG an Excellence of Design award from the Bucks County Chamber of Commerce and the American Institute of Architects.
